Sri Krishna Janmashthami

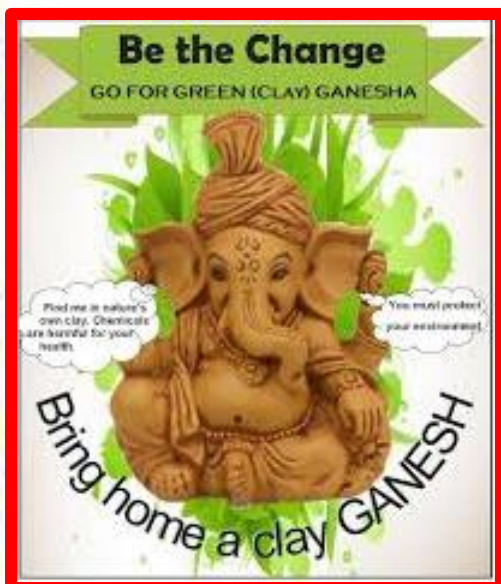
Was celebrated on **24th Aug.**
